If you consent to electronic disclosures, that consent applies to all Required Information we give you or receive from you in connection with our relationship and the associated notices, disclosures, and other documents.

All electronic disclosures shall be in full compliance with applicable laws and regulations. The provisions in this agreement are part of (and in supplement to) Terms and Conditions for Depository Accounts for CoreFirst Bank & Trust and are subject to all the provisions in the Terms and Conditions for Depository Accounts.

You agree to print out or download Required Information when we advise you to do so and keep it for your records. The required information will remain on the account opening website for 30 days for your access. If you are unable to print or download any Required Information, you may call us and request paper copies at no charge. If you need to update your e-mail address or other contact information with us, you may do so by calling us and requesting necessary updates.

You have the right to withdraw your consent to receive electronic communications at any time. To withdraw your consent to receive electronic communications, you must notify us via email, through our electronic banking services, or by writing and mailing to CoreFirst Bank & Trust, PO Box 5049, Topeka, KS 66605.
